

RGC's BIRTHDAY PARTY COVID POLICIES & PROCEDURES

POLICIES:

- ADULT & CHILD PPE/HEALTH
- COACHING STAFF PPE/HEALTH POLICY
- SANITIZATION

PROCEDURES:

- ENTERING

ADULT & CHILD PPE/HEALTH POLICY:

- Masks are required for the entire duration of your time in RGC for both adults & children 2 years old and up.
- Masks may only be removed when eating/drinking.
- All entering will be temperature checked at the door and given hand sanitizer once inside.
- **A maximum of 30 people per birthday are allowed inside, this includes the birthday child**
 - **This can be any combination of adults, siblings, & guests**

COACHING STAFF PPE/HEALTH POLICY:

- All staff are required to follow the same policies and procedures as gymnasts and families entering the building. This includes having their temperature checked, using hand sanitizer, and wearing a facemask.

SANITIZATION:

- All equipment and surfaces are sanitized with disinfectant between all classes, birthday parties, and at the end of each day.
- Bathrooms are wiped down with disinfectant at the end of each day as well.
- Hand sanitizer is available in the party room as well as inside the gym for everyone's convenience. Staff may ask children to sanitize after coughing, sneezing, touching their faces, or using the bathroom.

PROCEDURES:

ENTERING:

- All entering will be temperature checked at the door and given hand sanitizer once inside. **A temperature of 99.7 degrees fahrenheit or higher will be rechecked twice. If there's no change, that person will not be permitted entrance.**
- A staff member will be at the door **15 minutes before the start time of the party** to allow the host family time to set up any food and/or decorations in the party room.

RGC staff reserve the right to deny access to our facilities to anyone unwilling to follow the above policies and procedures.
